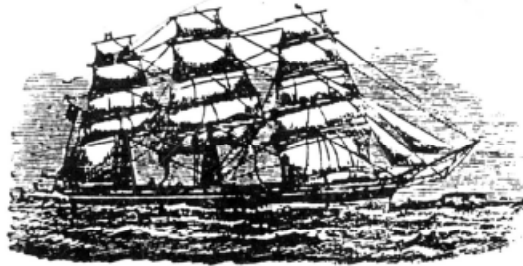

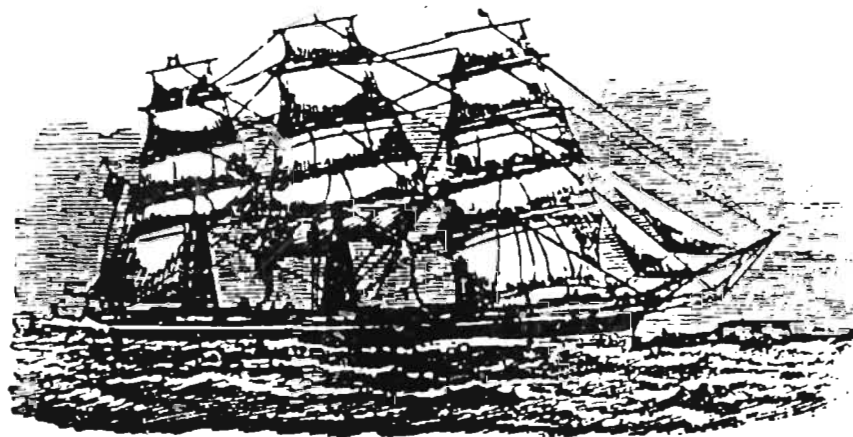

In recent years volunteer indexers compiled a card index to individual immigrants referring to particular pages within a book or register. The index in the present kit is based on the card index and retains the page and book number references. The book or register can be located on the following fiche:

# OUTLINE OF ASSISTED IMMIGRATION TO VICTORIA

Urban poverty in Britain, largely a result of the Industrial Revolution and the demand for labour in the colonies, led to increasing emigration to countries like Australia in the 19th century.

Altogether, many millions of Europeans abandoned family ties and invested their futures in the New World.

Between 1825-50, some three million people left Britain. More than two hundred thousand headed for Australasia. The first assisted immigrants left England for Australia in 1832.

Britain's social upheaval was made worse by such factors as the potato famine in Ireland, highland depopulation (the clearances) in Scotland, and the general misery of growing city slums. Dispersing unwanted families among the colonies, themselves desperate for people, seemed a mutually agreeable solution.

In Australia, all this was made possible by the activities of private companies and the proceeds from government land sales which helped to defray the costs of the 'Bounty System'. The bounty system encouraged settlers or their agents to select and arrange for the transportation of immigrants to the Australian Colonies. Upon their arrival in Australia payment per head of the healthy new arrivals was authorised.

## **Epic Voyages**

The sea voyages from Britain were seldom pleasant for the early settlers, and sometimes fatal. Disease and shipwreck were among the perils emigrants faced. Life at Australian destinations, although an improvement for most, did not always match the promises of the immigration agents.

## **Port Phillip District of New South Wales**

The flourishing seaports of the Port Phillip District, and the expansion of pastoral industry outside the towns, caused great demand for artisans and farm labourers. High wages proved persuasive in luring them to the new settlement of Melbourne.

In 1837, authority to use the proceeds of land sales for the introduction of free immigrants was granted. In addition, any surplus immigrants were to be sent from Sydney. The first of these arrived in the barque Hope on 3 January 1839, with 103 men, women and children.

## **Migration Temporarily Halted in the 1840s**

A financial depression in the 1840s led to virtual suspension of assisted immigration. During this period the British authorities sent out some ships with exiled convicts, a proportion of whom were diverted to Port Phillip. Upon arrival the 'exiles' as they became known were given a pardon on condition that they did not return to Britain for the unexpired term of their sentence.

Assistance to migrants meanwhile resumed in 1847. By the end of the decade, the population of Australia had more than doubled to a total of 405,000.



### **The Gold Rush and Beyond**

The Gold Rush to Victoria again doubled the Australian population between 1851-61. Most paid their own way, and official immigration schemes were largely eclipsed. Now, for the first time the population of Victoria was greater than New South Wales.

Assisted migration continued in various forms from the 1860s, and tapered off in the 1870s and, by the 1880s, had all but been abandoned in the rest of the Australian colonies. Altogether, about 650,000 people were assisted to move to Australia during the 19th century.

# INTRODUCING STAGE ONE OF THE BRITISH IMMIGRATION TO VICTORIA RESOURCE KIT

This resource kit contains facsimile nominal, disposal or combined nominal and disposal lists of almost all known British assisted immigrants to Victoria. Further additions to the kit will add lists and indexes of British unassisted passengers during the period 1852-1888.

The kit is divided into three sections:

## **SECTION 1 - INTRODUCTION (Fiche No 1)**

This section comprises:

- a) an outline of assisted migration
- b) instruction on using the resource kit
- c) a list of assisted immigrant ships 1839-1871
- d) suggestions for further research

## **SECTION 2 - REGISTERS OF ASSISTED IMMIGRANTS (Fiche No 2 - 124)**

The "Registers of Assisted Immigrants" comprise 20 volumes. They represent the surviving records in Victoria of over 130,000 assisted immigrants who entered the Colony between 1839-1871.

Some of the volumes appear to be working copies of records kept by staff of the Immigration Agent's Office, while others appear to be the final copy kept by that Office. For the period prior to 1852 duplicate copies of a number of ships' arrivals are held by the Archives Office of New South Wales. To find out more about those arrivals see Guide to the State Archives of New South Wales No 17. "Guide to Shipping and Free Passenger Records" (The Archives Authority of New South Wales).

Immigrants from all the countries that make up the British Isles are included in the Registers, that is England, Scotland, Wales and Ireland.

The Registers generally contain two types of record:

### **Nominal Lists:**

The Nominal List of Assisted Immigrants was usually completed on disembarkation of immigrants from their ship.

The Lists generally contain the following information:

- \* Name of the Immigrant [Given and Surname]
- \* Calling [Trade or Profession]
- \* Native Country of either England & Wales, Scotland or Ireland [often contains county or place living prior to emigration]
- \* Religious Denomination
- \* Education [if immigrant could read or write or both]
- \* Marital Status or relationship to head of family [if on board]
- \* Age of Adults
- \* Age of Children [not always accurate]

NB Nominal Lists are sometimes called Alphabetical Lists or Lists of Assisted Immigrants.

**Structure of Nominal Lists:**

In general the lists have the following structure:

- (a) **Heading:**  
gives name of ship, and in the majority of cases some or all of the following: date and place of embarkation, date and place of arrival. May also contain name of master and/or Surgeon Superintendent and tonnage of vessel.
- (b) **Family List:**  
Lists adult members of a family group plus children, usually those under 14 years of age.
- (c) **Single Males:**  
Lists all unmarried males over the age of 14 years. Lists include children of married couples on board.
- (d) **Single Females:**  
Lists all unmarried females over the age of 14 years. Lists include children of married couples on board.
- (e) **Births on Board:**  
Lists all births occurring during the voyage.
- (f) **Deaths on Board:**  
Lists all deaths occurring during the voyage.
- (g) **Cabin Passengers:**  
Some ships carried a small number of fare paying passengers as well as assisted immigrants and in many instances these passengers are listed separately in the Registers. These passengers are included in the index to assisted passengers.
- (h) **Other Information:**  
For some ships additional information such as copies of Immigration Board Reports and some statistics may be found. These are more likely to be found for arrivals occurring prior to the mid 1850s.

Names in all parts of the List are generally arranged in alphabetical order, but this was not always strictly adhered to.

**Disposal Lists:**

The Disposal List of Assisted Immigrants was usually created in the Immigrants' Depot after their arrival in the District/Colony and prior to leaving the depot. The List usually gives name and address of the immigrant's employer, the wage rate and if rations were to be supplied. It may also show the period of employment for which the immigrant was contracted. If an immigrant went to live or work with a relative the name and in some instances the address of the relative may be shown.

**Combined Lists:**

It is important to remember that some Disposal Lists and Nominal Lists are combined records whilst some are separate. A researcher should ensure that if separate lists survive they are consulted. Also in some cases there may be more than one Disposal List for a particular ship's arrival. It is advisable to check to see that all Lists have been seen. The List of Assisted Immigrant Ships would be useful in doing this.

### SECTION 3 - INDEX OF ASSISTED IMMIGRANTS (Fiche No 125 - 134)

The alphabetical "Index of Assisted Immigrants" is based on a card index compiled by staff of the State Library - Archives Division and volunteer indexers from the Genealogical Society of Victoria in the 1960s and early 1970s. During 1986/87, with the assistance of Commonwealth Employment Program funding, the first half of the index was put on a computer database. This task was then completed in 1988 with the assistance of the Titles Office.

Entries in the index are:

- \* Surname and Given Names of the Immigrant
- \* Ship
- \* Month and year of arrival
- \* Book Number of the Register
- \* Page Number in the particular Register

Each microfiche has an index to it's contents in the bottom righthand corner. This fiche contents index gives the first surname that appears on each frame of the fiche.

## HOW TO USE THE KIT

**Step 1.** Locate the microfiche in the **INDEX** which holds the surname you are interested in researching.

**Step 2.** Examine the entry or entries for that surname, noting the ship, book number and page number for all entries you are researching.

**STEP 3.** Next look at the **REGISTERS OF ASSISTED IMMIGRANTS** and locate the book number you want. Now find the page number in that book.

# LIST OF ASSISTED IMMIGRANT SHIPS TO PORT PHILLIP 1839 - 1871

## **INTRODUCTION:**

This list is intended to assist researchers in determining the following -

- \* the name and date of departure, and arrival of, assisted immigrant ships to the District of Port Phillip or the Colony of Victoria between 1839 and 1871;
- \* the book number in the Register of Assisted Immigrants where the arrival of a particular ship can be located;
- \* whether a nominal list, disposal list or both lists exist for each arrival;

## **USING THIS LIST:**

To use this list, find the name of the ship you are researching and then simply read across the page for the details of that voyage. If a ship had multiple voyages the entries for each ship are shown in date order of the different arrivals. Where lists for a particular vessel's arrival occur in different Registers there is an entry for each Register.

The details listed for each voyage are:

- \* Ship's Name
- \* Port of embarkation [usually the initial port if immigrants boarded at more than one port]
- \* Date of embarkation [sometimes inaccurate]
- \* Port of arrival in the District/Colony
- \* Date of arrival in the District/Colony
- \* Indicator if a Nominal and/or a Disposal List(s) have survived for the arrival [either Yes or a blank where no list has survived]
- \* Book number in the Register of Assisted Immigrants
- \* Notes on the particular voyage if required.

## **COMMENTS COLUMN:**

This List also contains a comments column. Where information has been readily available from the Registers or one of the other sources used to compile the list this has been included in the comments column. Some abbreviations have been used, as explained below.

Where a statement such as "Boys from Ragged Schools" is used this means that the passengers included a group of boys from the Ragged Schools.

NSWA refers to the Archives Office of New South Wales. This has been used where differences appear between the Registers and the Archives Office List of Assisted Immigrant Ships.

Highland and Island refers to vessels that included immigrants assisted to the Colony by the Highland and Island Immigration Society.

## **HOW THIS LIST WAS COMPILED:**

In the first instance details were compiled from the Registers of Assisted Immigrants [VPRS 14]. Where gaps appeared, information was obtained from the following sources:

- a. Annual Reports of the Immigration Agent [Votes and Proceedings Victorian Legislative Council and Assembly]

- b. Index of Ships Inwards 1839-1900 [VPRS 13]
- c. Guide to the State Archives of New South Wales No 17

## FURTHER RESEARCH

The holdings of the Public Record Office of Victoria commence with the records of Capt. William Lonsdale's pioneer administration in 1836. Today, more than 38 kilometres of official records are preserved at the PRO's Laverton North Repository. Records relating to the Central Highlands Region are held at the Ballarat Regional Repository. Nearly every sphere of government activity is covered including lands, legal matters and education. If further research is contemplated, the Public Record Office's List of Holdings should be consulted at any of the search rooms. Copies can be purchased at the Public Record Office Search Rooms or from the Victorian Government Bookshop.

### **ADMINISTRATION OF IMMIGRATION**

From its inception in 1839 assisted immigration was administered in the District/Colony by the Assistant Immigration Agent or the Immigration Agent. At different times the Immigration Agent was to be found in various parts of the Government administration:

- 1839-1851 within the Superintendent of Port Phillip Office
- 1851-1856 within the Colonial Secretary's Office
- 1856-1901 within the Department of Trade and Customs.

During the period 1847-1852 it appears that a separate Immigration Branch was set up within the Superintendent's Office and Colonial Secretary's Office as a separate record keeping system was established. For the period before and after this records appear in the main departmental records.

The Public Record Office holds a number of record series that relate to both assisted and unassisted immigration and to shipping. Some of the series concerned are detailed below.

The inward and outward correspondence of the following agencies contain much useful information to the researcher on immigration matters. The agencies concerned are:

- Police Magistrate, Port Phillip District
- Superintendent, Port Phillip District
- Superintendent, Port Phillip District - Immigration Branch
- Colonial Secretary's Office
- Chief Secretary's Office.

The following example gives an indication of the type of information that can be gathered from the correspondence records.

In 1852 the British Admiralty decided to send HMS Hercules to Hong Kong as a floating barracks. After discussions between the Highland and Island Immigration Society, the Board of Admiralty and the Colonial Land and Emigration Commissioners, the ship was made available for the conveyance of emigrants to Adelaide and Melbourne on the way to Hong Kong. By looking at the Indexes and Registers of Correspondence of the

Colonial Secretary's Office for 1853 it was possible to locate correspondence:

- advising Colonial Authorities of the use of the vessel and arrangements made for gratuities to senior members of the crew, advice on landing emigrants to prevent crew desertions to the goldfields, and advice on fitting out of the vessel for the voyage.
- advice of the vessel's arrival in Melbourne
- lists of provisions and stores put on board.

A nominal list and a disposal list are also contained in the Registers of Assisted Immigrants.

This short example provides an indication of the type of information that you may find on a particular voyage. For some vessels there may be more information, for others there may be less. As researchers you will need to do some detective work to find out what is available for a particular voyage. Other records you may find include reports of the Surgeon Superintendant and the Immigration Board.

All microfilm records listed above can be found at each Search Room.

The Index to British Inwards Passenger Lists is a large card index (about 375,000 entries) is located at the City Search Room.
